Keller Key

A Keller Key is presented at each commencement to the honor graduate(s) who, on the basis of having earned all credits for the bachelor's degree at this University, has made the highest scholastic average. The recipient(s) of the Keller Key will be identified by the registrar's office in accordance with established guidelines.

Turris Fidelis Award

The Turris Fidelis Award may be awarded to not more than two graduating seniors at spring commencement. Students who have graduated since the previous spring semester as well as those planning to graduate in the spring will be considered candidates for the award. The award is made on the basis of outstanding service to the University and scholastic achievement. This honor is the highest that can be conferred upon a graduating senior, and recipients are selected by a joint committee of faculty, staff, and students.
